


Preparations


- 1. The piece must be performed in a space where performers can gather in the centre and have free space to the sides, as well as backwards/forwards (e.g. a church).
- 2. Find and mark a *Starting Point* in the centre of the performance space.
- 3. Calculate the distance to the wall in each direction (forward/backward/left/right).
- 4. Divide the distance with 45. This is the length of one *Step*.
- 5. During rehearsals, each performer should walk his/her part before performing, and invisibly or visibly mark the respective spots of performance.
- 6. Before concert, each performer should tune one standard flute (flauto grande) each, and place by the wall in his/her direction.


Performance


- Walk slowly in silence to the Starting Point, together but without contact. Take some time to reflect on all the single moments that led you up to this single moment.
- Start piece in silence, back to back.
- When instructed to walk (just before A):
 - Contrabass flute moves towards stage.
 - Piccola moves towards back wall.
 - Alto flute moves towards right wall.
 - Bass flute moves towards left wall.
- Take required number of steps until you play next tone. Move slowly, in a continuous pace.
- Before playing each tone, turn according to instructions.

























2 Alto Flute
